

Ray of Hope – Westmoreland County Suicide Awareness & Prevention Task Force

Committee & Meeting Information

Here is information about all our committees, task force meetings, and the newly formed L.O.S.S. Team. The L.O.S.S. Team will not have an opening for a while. If you are interested, I will make a note of that for when we offer the training again.

Walk Committee

Meets virtually every 4th Wednesday of the month January thru September at 1:00 PM The 19th Annual walk is September 6th, 2025 at Twin Lakes Park in Latrobe Last year we had over 400 people attend the walk. It is a beautiful, emotional, and healing event.

Marketing/Outreach/Education Committee

Meets virtually every 4th Wednesday of the month after the Walk Committee Meeting starting between approx. 1:30-2:00 PM from April-September and at 1:00 PM October and November This committee works on various events/trainings/projects. In April we will begin planning for our Annual Conference which takes place in November of every year.

Tabling Committee

This group does not have regular meetings to attend. They are volunteers that go out to events, usually in pairs, setup the Ray of Hope Table/Tent and talk to people who stop by the table. Committee members are required to come to MHA or an event to learn about all the different marketing materials/brochures we display on our table.

Veteran Committee

Meets in person every first Monday of the month at 10:00 AM at Mental Health America. On June 21st, 2025, we are hosting our 2nd Annual Veteran Corn Hole Tournament at the Jeannette American Legion. It was very successful last year! You DO NOT have to be a veteran to participate in this committee.

Scholarship Committee

This committee meets on an as needed basis. The work is primarily done via email during March – May.

We award \$1,000 Scholarship to a Westmoreland County graduating senior.

Loss Survivor / Celebration of Life Committees

The Celebration of Life event is for those who have lost someone to suicide to celebrate their lives and to offer help and hope during the holidays. We meet July - December. We typically meet around 4:30 PM at Panera at Westmoreland Mall once a month. This committee also

plans a Candlelight Vigil to be held in November outside of the Westmoreland County Courthouse.

Spring Spectacular Committee

This committee meets October through April, usually a hybrid of in-person and virtually during the work day. We usually meet at the JPO office in Greensburg. This is a HUGE event held at the Westmoreland County Fairgrounds the first weekend in April for families with food trucks, the Easter bunny, a huge egg hunt, prizes, tons of resource tables, a DJ, etc.

Lethal Means Safety Committee

This committee was started in April of 2025. The meetings are a hybrid of in-person and virtual on the 1st Wednesday of the month at 9:30. The in-person portion is held at Mental Health America. Most suicide crises are brief (less than an hour). When a firearm is used in a suicide attempt it is 85-90% fatal. Some of this committee's goals are to:

- Educate the public and providers on Lethal Means Safety by providing trainings
- Reach out to gun shop owners in Westmoreland County to start a dialog and host a networking event
- Provide free gun locks
- Design promo item/s that can be distributed to the public, veterans, and gun shops to promote the WC crisis line, 988, and Ray of Hope
- And More

General Task Force Meeting

The Task Force has a general meeting for the entire membership quarterly in March, June, September, & December on the 3rd Thursday of the month at 12:00. We are experimenting with bringing back a few in-person meetings. The June Meeting (6:00 PM) and December Holiday Luncheon are in person.

L.O.S.S. Team

This not a committee. This is a trained team made up of caring community members and suicide loss survivors trained to reach out to newly bereaved suicide loss survivors. LOSS stands for Local Outreach to Suicide Survivors. A LOSS Team is an active model of postvention that involves two or more trained volunteers who go to the scene of a suicide to provide immediate support to those left behind. Having a LOSS Team at the scene of a suicide provides loss survivors with practical support, a connection to resources, and most importantly, an instillation of hope.
